Art. 1.1 Preamble

This event will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations (FIA CCRSR) including appendices, the WADA/NADA Codes, and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations of the countries the event passes shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply. Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins. Art. 6.1 Obligatory organiser's advertising

The stickers must be placed **horizontally** along the **edge of the front doors** (driver and co-driver sides), with the **race number positioned toward the front** of the vehicle.

The **top edge of the sticker** must be positioned **7 to 10 cm** below the **bottom edge of the window**.

- Windshield sticker placed at the two upper corner: 25x10cm

Art. 6.2 Optional organiser's advertising

For Groups **T3-T4**, a **metal bracket** fixed to the rear rollbars can be added to allow the correct affixing of these panels.

Art. 7. Fuel

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (Art. 56 of the FIA CCRSR).

Art. 8. Administrative checks

At the administrative both members- driver or the co-driver must be present.

The documents required for administrative checks (listed below) must be sent to the following email address: julianna@garzonerracing.com.

Art. 8.1 Documents to be presented:

During the administrative checks the following original and valid documents will be checked:

- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and navigator's competition licences (if one of the drivers should be the competitor, he must also hold a competitors' licence)
- Driver's and navigator's ID cards/passports
- Driver's and navigator's valid driving licences valid for the vehicle entered.
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car registration papers
- FIA Technical Passport (1st page with the passport number)

The **Competitor** is the only responsible for the **validity of the different administrative documents** required to participate in the **ITALIAN BAJA 2025** and in particular the **validity of the driving licence, vehicle registration papers and vehicle insurance**.

Art. 9.2 Timetable

Individual times will be allocated for each team.

The race director may impose a €50 fine for each delay.

Art. 9. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

10.1. Scrutineering, venue and time:

The race car may be presented for scrutineering by the team representative. See the Programme. The cars must already have the organizer-provided **stickers applied**.

Art. 9.1.1 Time, schedule

Individual times will be allocated for each team.

The race director may impose a €50 fine for each delay.

Art. 9.2 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete original FIA Homologation Document (if applicable)
- For STK cars: FIA homologation form
- FIA / ASN Technical Passport (if applicable)
- Annual 'Safety Equipment' sheet (for driver and co-driver clothing)

The installation of the tracking system and **NAV-GPS** will be checked during scrutineering. All documents must **also** be presented during the **final scrutineering**.

Art. 9.3 Mud flaps

Mud flaps must always be in place and must comply with the provisions of Appendix J.

Art. 9.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All competitors are required to wear only **approved protective clothing** (overalls, underwear, shoes, gloves, socks, balaclava/cap under the helmet), in accordance with **FIA 8856-2000 or 8856-2018 standards**, as specified on the website www.acisport.it.

Art. 9.5 Installation of the GPS Navigation and Safety Tracking System

Art. 9.5.1 Safety Tracking System

All participants are required to use the **GPS tracking and navigation system provided by the organizer**.

Instructions for using the GPS tracking system can be found in **Appendix 5 of the Supplementary Regulations**.

Art.9.5.2 Navigation System

Competitors are obliged to be equipped with one or two **Navigation System(s) (NAV-GPS)** downloaded with the **waypoints** given by the Organiser. When a crew uses two NAV-GPS, the primary one will be **identified** by the supplier **with a distinctive label**.

Art.9.5.3 Connection of the Systems

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the **tracking system(s) and the NAV-GPS remain connected and powered on throughout the entire duration of the event**, including the proper connection of the antenna.

Art.9.5.4 On-Board Cameras

According to point 11 of the **RDS 2025 General Regulations**.

Art.9.5.5 Electronic Equipment

Any radio or electronic means of communication, or any other device not expressly permitted in FIA CCSR regulations is forbidden on board the vehicles.

Art. 10. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 10.1 Briefing

See Programme

At the first briefing of the event, the participation of **at least one crew member is compulsory**.

In case of absence or late arrival at the briefing, a **€500 fine** will be imposed by the **CCSS** (see Appendix I, Article 23.1.8).

Art. 10.2 Start place and time

- The **Pre-Start Area** will be set up in the same place as the **Parc Fermè**, competitors **MUST** enter the Pre-Start Area as specified in article 3 of the program in these rules.
- The Pre-start area **will be controlled**. Access will be limited to crew members, **VIPs and media with appropriate identification/accreditation**.
- Cars must be driven by **one of the drivers or a team representative** in the Pre-Start Area, where **any kind of service is strictly prohibited**; Any kind of infraction will be reported to the Stewards.
- Any entry and any delay in the pre-start area outside the time window indicated in art. 3 of these regulations will be sanctioned by the C.d.C. with a fine of 100 €.

Art. 10.6 Finish procedures

At the end of the stage, all cars shall pass the finish ramp (Fiera – Hall 5) for interviews and then go to the Parc Fermé until its opening on the instructions of the Stewards.

- The prize-giving ceremony will take place at the "Parterre" in Hall 5 of the Fair at 22.00.
- After having parked their vehicles in the Parc Fermé at the passage of the finish line, the participants' team (Crew) must remain available by telephone (mobile phone) until the publication of the final classification.
- The podium and prize-giving will take place according to Article 3 of these regulations. The presence of both crew members is mandatory.
- The prize-giving will take place by awarding prizes to the first group and then to the first five in descending order according to the provisional overall classification.

Art. 10.7 Permitted early check-in.

P1A – P1B – 1C - 4A

Art. 10.8 Road Book delivery

It is distributed daily, 20 minutes before the start time of the respective stage.

Art. 10.9 Servicing of vehicles

Art. 10.9.1 Servicepark

From TCP0 onwards, service of a competing car may be carried out in Service Areas and road sections as permitted under the FIA CCRSR.

The speed of vehicles in the service parks/bivouacs may not exceed 30kph

Each team must first go to the **Service Accreditation Centre (SAC):**

GPS coordinates: N 45°56.836' – E 12°39.301'.

TRUCKS (over 3500kg):

South gate (N 45° 56.853' –E 12° 39.230')

Entry is ONLY permitted on Wednesday **02 July** from **09.00** to **13.00**

SERVICE VEHICLES (less than 3500kg):

South gate (N 45° 56.853' – E 12° 39.230')

Entry is permitted on Wednesday **02 July** from **13.00** to **21.00** and Thursday **03 July** from **08.00** to **14.00**

SAC will be open on Wednesday 02 July from **09.00** to **21.00** and Thursday **03 July** from **08.00** to **14.00** (only for the "Service Vehicles"), and there will receive the service plates and instructions to follow for the own service area.

All the Teams will be placed by the Organizer in the Service Areas.

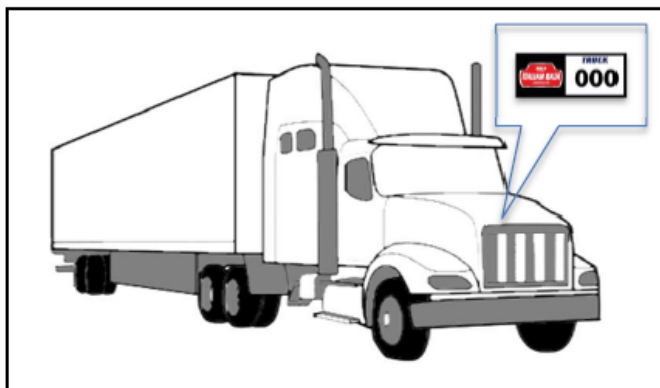
Once positioned, only the service or passenger transport vehicles equipped with a pass (Service, Team Manager) will be able to enter and exit the service park. The rest of the vehicles will not be able to leave the Service Park until the end of the event.

One "Service" plate will be provided to each competitor for free, which can be used for any vehicle, except truck.

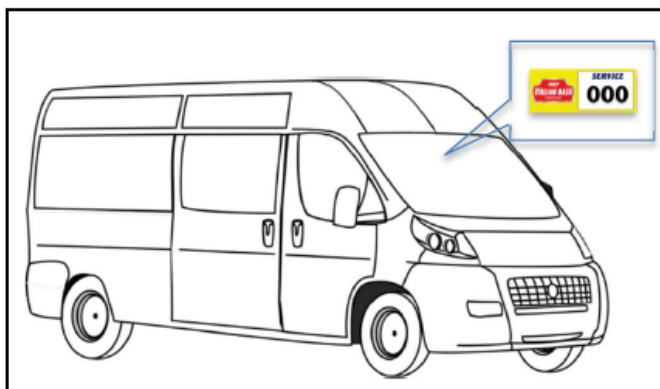

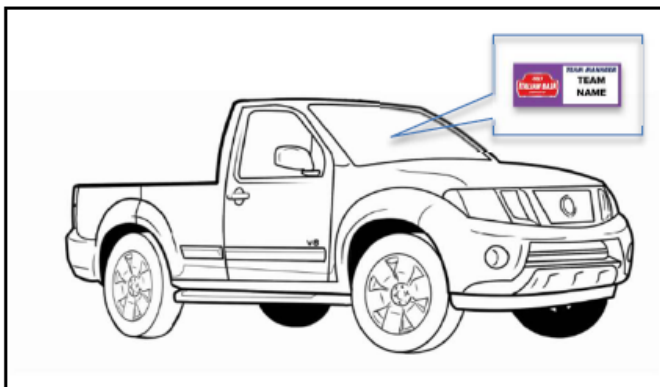
"TRUCK" Plate:

- Vehicles over 3500kg.
- These vehicles can enter the service park ONLY on Wednesday, 02 July from 9:00 to 13:00 and must be parked there until the end of the event.



"SERVICE" Plate:

- Vehicles less than 3,500 kg (van) used as service assistance.
- These vehicles can enter in the service park every day of the event.



"TEAM MANAGER" Plate:

- Vehicles less than 3,500 kg for the transfer of the team staff.
- These vehicles can enter in the service park every day of the event.

10.9.3 Service allowed in Selective Section

Any kind of assistance is **prohibited on the Selective Sections**. Only teams that are **still competing in the current stage / SS** are allowed to provide **mutual assistance**.

Art. 10.9.4 Fuel and Refuelling Zone

Except as detailed for the change of a fuel tank, refuelling in the service area is not permitted at any time.

The crews may refuel only in the designated Refuelling Zone (RZ) or at commercial filling stations indicated in the Road book.

The Refuelling Zone (RZ) will be at:
Pordenone Fiere: "Parking SUD" (N 45°56.775' - E 12°39.142')

It is mandatory to reserve the area for refuelling.

In the RZ the procedures according to Art. 54.2 of the FIA CCRSR must be followed. To access the RZ, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava. Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation and the crew must remain outside the vehicle during refuelling. According to article 54.1.6 of the FIA CCRSR the team is responsible for the refuelling and must protect the ground with an environmental mat. This applies not only to the actual refuelling process but also to the handling and storage of the tank barrels. Any infringement will be reported to the Steward.

Art. 13. Final checks / Protests / Appeals

Art. 13.1 Final Checks

Any teams required to undergo final checks must immediately follow the instruction of the marshals in charge, even if this prevents them from proceeding to one or more time controls (TC).

The complete original FIA homologation form, the FIA Passport and the vehicle's technical documentations must be available for final checks.

Art. 13.2 Protest deposit

The appeal fees are specified in point 5.2 of Appendix 9 of the NSR.

If a protest requires the disassembly and reassembly of a clearly defined vehicle part, any additional deposit will be determined by the stewards based on the recommendation of the technical delegate.

In addition to the technical protest fee, the stewards may require a disassembly deposit based on the technical delegate's recommendation. If the protest is unfounded, the cost of reassembly shall also be borne by the protesting party.

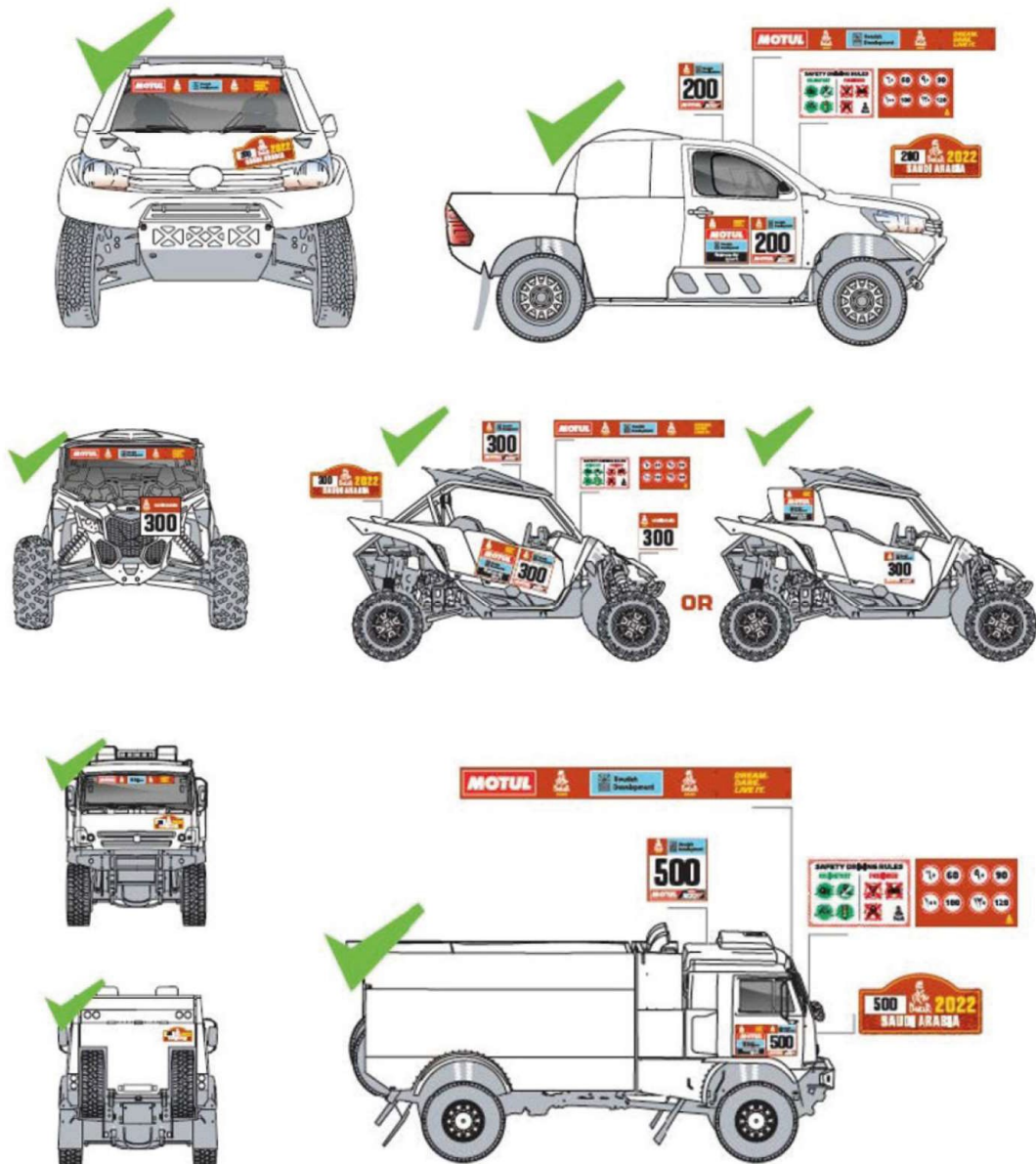
