An entry application will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fees. The entry fee must be credited in full to the organiser's bank account.

According to the FIA International Sporting Code, foreign competitors/drivers must have their ASN's permission, which should be attached to the entry form (ASN's stamp on the entry, or the ASN's written permission to take part in the competition, or the licences copies with the described permissions in them)

Any entry which is not accompanied with the entry fee will be considered as a preliminary one.

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected

The organiser may partially refund entry fees, if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure. The deduction will be:

- 50% of the entry fee for the requests received until 20 days before the administrative checks.
- 100% of the entry fee for the requests received less than 19 days before the administrative checks.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

Insurance will be done in accordance with Art. 15 of the 2021 FIA CCRSR.

Name of the insurance company: SRC SPECIAL RISK CONSORTIUM GMBH, Kuniberts kloster 7-9, D 50668 KÖLN.

The limit of the responsibility is 3.000.000 Eur.

In case of an accident leading to insurance event, the competitor or his representative must make a written statement to the Clerk of the Course, the Competitors Relations Officer, or directly to the

Organizer, within 24 hours. This statement must mention the accident circumstances, the names and addresses of the casualties, as well as contact details of the witnesses.

The organiser will provide each crew with the number identification (67x22cm), which must be affixed to their car in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. **It is not allowed to cut the panel.**

Art. 7. Tyres

Art. 7.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the event

Art. 8. Fuel

Refuelling is permitted only in commercial fuel stations using fuel on sale to the public. Only the crew may carry out this procedure. Refuelling stations authorised will be indicated in the Road Book with "FUEL STATION".

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (Art. 57 of the FIA CCRSR).

Art. 9. Administrative checks

Before Administrative Check, each vehicle must Register at Suzuki Mészáros, Grábler Tó str.10, where the Checklist and Service Plates will be provided.

Art. 9.1 Documents to be presented:

To keep the time required for the administrative checks to the necessary minimum, make sure to bring and present the following documents:

- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences
- Driver's and co-driver's ID cards/passports
- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences valid for the vehicle entered
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car registration papers
- Car insurance cover
- FIA Technical Passport
- FIA Homologation form for T2 vehicles
- Certificate of ownership of the vehicle or authorization from the registered owner

Art. 9.2 Timetable

See programme (SR Art. 3)

The following additional procedures will apply:

- Administrative checks should, whenever possible, be carried out together with the collection of rally materials and documents.
- Notwithstanding Art. 22.1 of FIA CCR SR, drivers and co-drivers are not required to report personally to the administrative checks. Each Competitor shall nominate in advance to the Rally Organizer one authorized representative to complete administrative checks and collect the rally materials and documents, provided in plastic bags. In order to receive the package, administrative checks must be fully completed.

The original documents required for the Administrative Check must be presented for visual inspection.

Individual times for administrative checks will be published for each competitor in 'Organizer's communication' and published on the website: www.hungarianbaja.com.

A time control before the Administrative Checks (C1) will be arranged, according to the individualized timetable.

Another time control after the Administrative Checks end will be arranged.

Any delay to the C1 control will be penalized as follows:

- From 1 to 15 minutes: 150€ fine
- From 16 to 30 minutes: 250€ fine
- From 31 to 60 minutes: 500€ fine
- More than 60 minutes: 500€ fine and report to the Stewards.

Art. 10. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

See Article 23 and Article 24 of the FIA CCRSR.

Art. 10.1 Scrutineering, venue and time

Location: Suzuki Mészáros, Grábler Tó str. 10.

Time: 05.08.2021. 10:00-21:00 according to scheduled time for each crew!

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team. See programme (SR Art. 3)

An individual schedule will be published in the web site www.hungarianbaja.com.

Please notice, that with respect to Appendix S ISC FIA, Scrutineering – 1 or max 2 people for car, (2 to remove underbody protection / 1 person for checking the equipment / 1 person for sealing spare parts). PPE is required for all team entering scrutineering.

There will be a time control before the Scrutineering (C3). The competitors should check-in to this time control according the individual schedule.

Any delay to the C3 control will be penalized as follows:

- From 1 to 15 minutes: 150€ fine
- From 16 to 30 minutes: 250€ fine
- From 31 to 60 minutes: 500€ fine
- More than 60 minutes: 500€ fine and report to the Stewards.

Art. 10.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete original FIA Homologation Document (if applicable)
- FIA Technical Passport
- Certificate of ownership of the vehicle or authorization from the registered owner
- Current vehicle registration document for the home country
- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

Art. 10.1.2 Timetable for scrutineering

After passing the Scrutineering, competitors must put their vehicles in the Park Ferme

Art. 10.2 Mud flaps

According Art. 25.3.4 of the FIA CCRSR, the use of mud flaps in compliance with the Art 283-19 is compulsory.

Art. 10.3 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III. In compliance with Art.48.1.and Appendix III of 2021 FIA CCRSR the medical kit and survival kit (the medical kit must come from the FIA technical list No. 83.) are mandatory.

Art. 10.4 Special national requirements

According the hungarian traffic rules, using headlight is compulsory on the road sections and in selective sections too.

Art. 10.5 Installation of the Safety Tracking System

Art. 10.5.1 Tracking System

All vehicles must only be fitted with the Safety Tracking System(s) provided by the Organiser. The instruction for the use of the Tracking System is in the Appendix 5 of these Supplementary Regulations. Delivery and installation of the equipment will be carried out before the administrative checks. Every competitor must return the equipment at the end of the competition, or, if a crew retires.

Art. 10.5.2 Navigation System (NAV-GPS)

Installation of the Safety Tracking System and Navigation System

Tracking System

All vehicles must only be fitted with the M-Info Safety Tracking System provided by the Organiser. M-Info safety system elements will be delivered and mounted by members of M-Info GPS team, during the Scrutineering.

The rent fee for the M-Info Safety System unit is included in the entry fee.

Each Crew must also pay to the organizer 100 EUR of refundable deposit for each complete safety system set, which will be returned upon return of undamaged and complete set.

The system manual is presented in Appendix 5 to SR.

Navigation System (NAV-GPS)

M-Info Safety system will be used as official NAV-GPS to control the Speed Control Zones, Passage Controls and Waypoints (without navigations function).

Art. 10.5.3 Connection of the Systems

The specifications for the standard power connector are laid down in the FIA CCRSR Appendix VI and Appendix 5 to these SR`s.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the M-InfoSafety Tracking System always remains permanently connected and switched on with the antenna connected throughout the duration of the competition.

Art. 11. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 11.1 Ceremonial start procedures and order

The event Grand Opening Ceremonial Start will be held at 20:30 6th August at the front of Thury Castle. After the ceremony, crews proceed to Parc Ferme.

Art. 11.6 Road Book delivery

Road books delivery for all Legs will take place on Friday, 06 August 2021, at the Briefing from 15:45.

Art. 11.7 Special procedures and activities

Art. 11.7.1 Availability of participants

Participants who park their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification have been posted.

Art. 11.7.2 Classification

The final classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on the website on the Digital Notice Board www.hungarianbaja.com and www.chronomoto.hu

Art. 11.8 Official time used during the event

The official time is the GPS time. (GMT+1)

Art. 11.9 Electronic start procedure at the start of a Selective Section

The start of the selective section is happening based on an electric clock and lamp, connected to a false start alert system.

When the car arrives at the start line, the front of the car should be positioned behind a stick placed by the marshal to define the exact start position. One minute before the start time, but not before the car has stopped in its exact position, the marshal shall remove the stick and the crew shall refer to the automatic countdown clock. Any subsequent change of the car's position until its start time is not permitted and will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 11.10 Service

Art. 11.10.1 Service Areas / Bivouacs

Access to the service park will only be permitted for vehicles, identified by the Organizer, showing the Service Plates, provided by the Organizer at the Registration. Accompanying team cars can enter only by purchasing a 200€ sticker at the Administrative Checks(1 service plate/team is provided by the organizer).

Tampering with or falsification of these plates will lead to disqualification of the team to which these service vehicles belong, on the decision of the Stewards. Plates will be placed in a visible area inside of the front windscreen of the vehicle.

Work on a competing car will be permitted only at service areas specified by the Organization.

LOCATION: Várpalota, Fehérvári str.17

Number of team members working in the Service Park and their identification are in accordance with V2-Art. 50.2.4. of the 2021 FIA CCRSR.





Appendix 4 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) **as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 48.1.**

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)


The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.

MEDICAL AND SURVIVAL KIT (Appendix III of the Cross-County Rally Sporting Regulations)

A sealed and valid Medical kit in accordance with the Specification for Cross Country Rallies and Bajas (Technical List n°83) must be placed inside the cockpit. The minimum weight must comply with Technical List n°83.

General operating principle of GPS measurements:

The GPS is an advanced positioning system for three-dimensional position determination, timing and velocity measurements can be carried out by land, sea or air. Accuracy is typically of the order of meters, but the environmental conditions can affect significantly. In the sky from the flat ground there are 7-25 satellites visible at the same time, of which for positioning at least three, for the height above sea level one additional satellite is necessary for determination. The GPS satellites are broadcasting at six frequencies. Each satellite broadcasts spread spectrum signal which may be "pseudo-random noise" called for.

The positioning is based on the theory of analytic geometric methods. The satellite positioning system is based on timing recycle distance measurement. Since we know the velocity of radio waves, and we know the date of issue and receipt of radio waves, can be determined based on the distance of the source of these. In the three-dimensional space knowing the exact measured distance from three known positions we are able to determine the position. Measuring the distance with other satellites we are able to improve this value.

Cause A significant distortion in the system can be caused by the effect of atmospheric to the radio waves. At the description of the calculations we assumed that to simply calculate with the distance = rate x time formula. This is true, but that the speed of radio waves are only constant in the vacuum pressure.

Evaluation of data

The evaluation of uploaded data can be determined inf two different ways.

Initial assessment of the competition supervision interface, real time data available online. This means the data that the device has been uploaded to the central database and downloaded online, analyzed by the supervisory program. The yet uploaded, or not yet analyzed data will be carried over in the subsequent analysis. Not uploaded data case occurs when the device is in the absence of strenght of GSM signal, and can not upload data to the central database. In the

case where the data is available online in the database, but local network is busy or the downloads has interrupted due to bad network relationship, then the analysis of loss data only partially can take place online.


Alternate method is retrospective data analysis. In this case, the data collected what has been received by a specified time interval sets the database to a file, and the data can be evaluated from point to point.

Vehicle to Vehicle Alarm (VTVA) function

The device has a frequency of 433 MHz using radio module, which is broadcasting the data of an encoded in advance "bagpipe" and SOS functions corresponding sets of data, for the tools staying in range. The range distance can be greatly affected by ambient atmospheric conditions and terrain. The device has adjustable transmission power. This value is not possible adjustable during the race. Currently, the vehicle to vehicle alarm system has two functions:

- "Toot" function, which indicates the overtaking intent of a VTVA equipped car up to 100m distance. Pressing the SOS button, placed in the box, a red LED indicates the start, which lasts for 5 seconds. In the event that the other device receives the sent signal, then this confirms to the sending device and the server uploads the signal, and at the same time, in the overtaken vehicle's SOS panel's LED will lit blue with a beep sound (continuous), and in the overtaker's vehicle the LED color changes from red to blue light, no beep sound here. The indicator remains on the overtaken's vehicle for 10 seconds. Then, each signal is switched off until a next signal.

- Send SOS signal devices within range. This feature will be active if on the SOS panel, the SOS switch is turned on. Send the device continues the signal, until the SOS switch is turned on. In the case where a device receives the SOS signal, on the SOS panel the red and blue LED will blink, with a pulse (0.5 s) alarm signal, as long as is still within range. This feature requires a power supply operation.

Tool installation

- SOS panel, vehicle to vehicle alarm system antenna placement: Previously purchased SOS panel's red and black wires with the 2poled TMWS2T connector must be connected to the 5A fuse mating port (horizontal shoe positive, vertical shoe negative polarity), 15 poled connector's end has to be wired with the right B column. SOS panel should be placed on the dashbord in such a way that both the driver and the navigator can reach. The adhesive antenna supplied shall be affixed to the top right corner of the windshield horizontally, the end of the cable wired to the right-hand column B.

- Installing the device: The device received at the Administrative check must be connected to the previously purchased and installed SOS panel and vehicle to vehicle alarm system antenna. The device must be fixed in the right column B with 2 clamps so that the device does not move and the visibility ensured.




Pic.No. 3.: How to install 1.4

- At the end of the race the device should be returned to the colleagues, where the deposit will be repayed. In case if the device has any problem, until identifying the problem, the competitor is entitled to the deposit only after a corresponding deduction.
